### Nantclwyd-y-Dre

15th Century Timber Hall House and newly restored walled gardens dating from Medieval times. Features such as the rose pergola, nuttree, and flowering meads demonstrate the garden's historic uses - for medicine, cooking and sensory pleasure. The orchard is host to traditional varieties of apple and pear and a Deneb Plum. Along the paths are fruit bushes, medlar, quince and mulberry, a fantastic display of wild pollards and an undisturbed 'old cemetery'. Unique views of the historic town, Castle and surrounding hills can be enjoyed from the garden's hidden, elevated position.

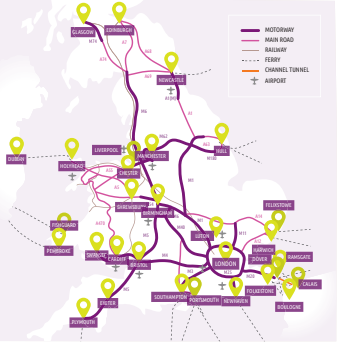

**Chirk Castle**

Chirk Castle was built in the late 13th century by Marcher Lord Roger Mortimer during the reign of King Edward I.

Sir Thomas Myddelton bought the castle in 1595, and his descendants continued to live at Chirk for over 400 years. The first formal garden was laid in the 17th century, with later alterations by William Emes and then Norah Lindsay. The current garden covers 5.5 acres of manicured lawns, clipped yews, herbaceous borders, beautiful rose, shrub and rock gardens, the wooded Pleasure Ground and the 18th century ha-ha.

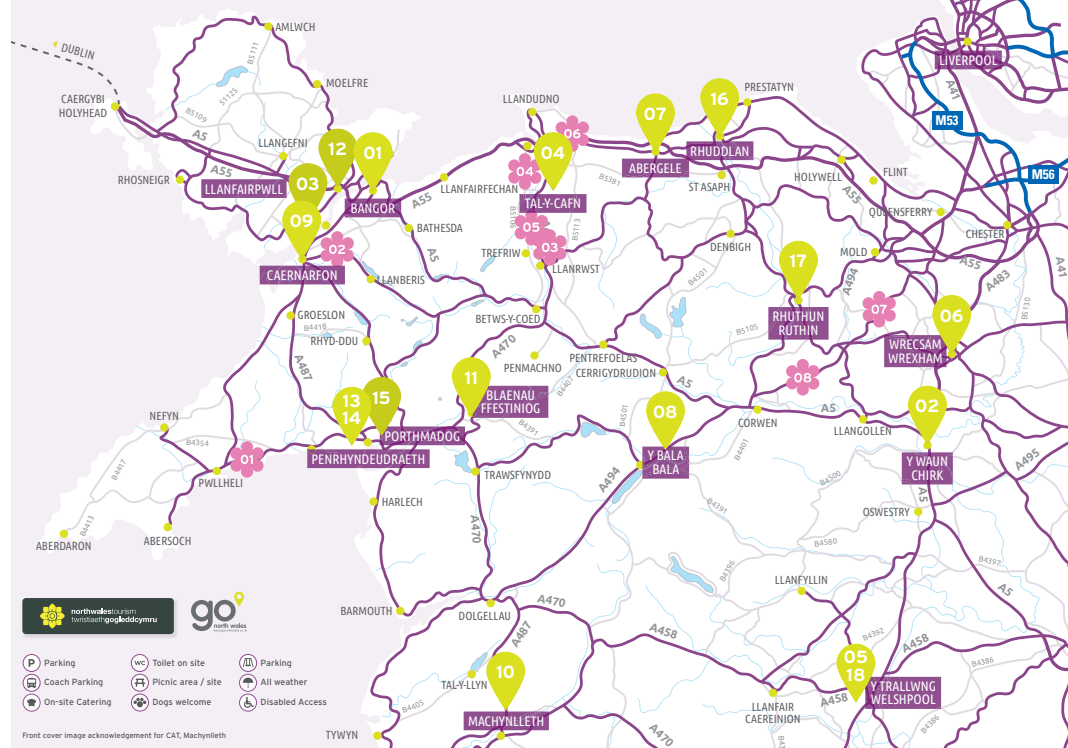

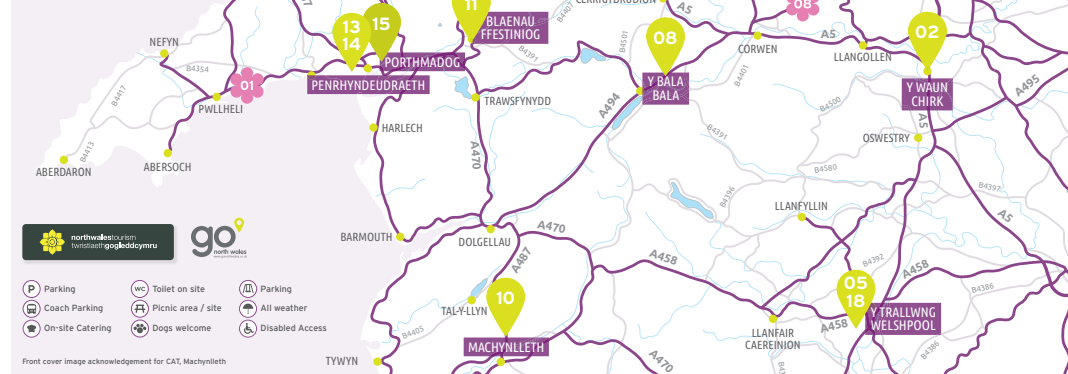
